4	November 18, 2010 regular meeting of the Teachers' Retirement
5	Board by calling the roll.

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2 MR. SERRANO: Any opposed? Any abstentions? Hearing 3 none, we will continue. Before we continue with the Agenda, 4 I would like to take a minute to introduce two staff members 5 at the end of the table. Annette Hanrahan is now our Director of Information Technology. Bob, who was previously our Director 6 7 of Information Technology has now been elevated to our Chief 8 Information Officer. Andrew Bradford is now our Chief Risk 9 Officer. Both Annette and Andrew have been with us many years and have a great, proven track record and we look forward to 10 11 working with them. Congratulations.

12 The next item on the Agenda is Updates on TRS Operations. MS. REILLY: The Annual Benefits Statements ("ABS") began 13 mailing on November 15th. We will be mailing approximately 14 113,000 statements to our members. We anticipate that the 15 mailing should be completed by the end of November. Our 16 Quarterly Account Statements ("QAS") for the third quarter 17 started mailing on November 17th. We will be mailing over 18 19 108,000 statements and we expect that mailing to also be 20 completed by the end of November. We also completed the 21 mailing of our quarterly Tax-Deferred Annuity ("TDA") Statements for 39,000 members with TDA deferral status. We completed 22 that on November 15th. In addition, we also mailed 461 TDA 23 Beneficiary Statements on November 5th. TRS began its TDA 24 25 Fall Campaign this month in order to promote awareness of

TRS Regular Board Meeting, NOVEMBER 18, 2010 1 2 our TDA program as a supplemental retirement plan. Posters 3 were sent to schools with the message, "Your bridge to a 4 Secure Retirement." We also made updates to our website 5 promoting the TDA program and have included an article in the TRS newsletter. On Saturday, November 13th, the TRS Member 6 7 Services Team and Stakeholder Relations Unit participated in the 46th CSA Leadership Conference. In preparation for this 8 9 member outreach initiative, 400 TRS informational kits 10 containing various brochures, TDA flyers, and member education program registration forms were assembled. Our Member Education 11 Department also hosted a presentation at the conference entitled 12 "TRS Benefits Working For You." Attendance was standing-room 13 only for the presentation and we received good feedback 14 15 regarding the presentation from members who attended.

16 MR. SERRANO: Thank you. The next item is just a reminder that you have an updated Calendar of Events and that you will 17 be receiving them every two (2) months now. The next item on 18 19 the Agenda is the Executive Director's Report. The first item 20 there is the Next Meeting. It has been suggested that the next 21 regular meeting of the Teachers' Retirement Board be held on the third Thursday of the month, December 16, 2010. The next 22 23 item is the laid-over resolution concerning electing a 24 chairperson.

25 MS. ROMAIN: Please lay it over.

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2 MR. SERRANO: The next item is just a Notification. Last 3 month, we passed a resolution that made reference to a prior 4 resolution. The date indicated in the prior resolution was 5 incorrect. The date initially mentioned was October 18, 2007 6 but the correct date should be October 25, 2007. This 7 notification is just to correct the record. It does not need 8 to be voted upon again.

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9 The next item is a Budget Modification to Support Analysis 10 to Improve TDA and Variable Services. I would like to give you 11 all a little bit of background on that. As I have mentioned 12 previously, TRS is exploring the introduction of enhanced 13 services for its Variable and TDA participants. This resolution 14 is requesting to engage the resources necessary to research 15 these services and the technical support necessary.

A significant amount of effort and cost will go towards an analysis of the alternative ways to modernize our computer system to support these new business requirements, and to work with outside resources to develop a detailed implementation plan, including true time and cost estimates for each alternative.

22 Before I identify some of the features we are exploring, 23 please note that some of them, such as the Roth TDA, could only 24 be implemented if later directed by the Board and/or enabling 25 legislation is passed. The type of features we are looking at

1 TRS Regular Board Meeting, NOVEMBER 18, 2010 2 are: Daily Fund Valuations (currently, we only value the funds 3 monthly and publish a unit value 15 days into the following 4 month); Daily Account Valuation (currently, accounts are only 5 updated on a monthly basis); On-line Real-time Account 6 Information through the TRS Web-site (currently, there is a 7 3 to 7 week lag between posting updated account balances and it 8 is an area of dissatisfaction for the members); Immediate, End-9 of-Day Fund Conversions (currently, member can only request fund conversions quarterly and it takes 3 to 12 months to complete 10 11 the conversion); Roth TDAs (which are permitted by recently 12 federal legislation); More Fund Choices and the ability to 13 establish those new funds more quickly (we currently have 6 investment options); On-line User Friendly Transaction Requests 14 with Rapid Turn-around Times through the TRS Web-site (based 15 on surveys we have heard from our members that they are 16 17 interested in having more of these types of features on-line); Account Balancing / Periodic Re-balancing (members who are 18 interested in maintaining a particular mix in their funds have 19 20 to monitor themselves and then initiate fund conversions and 21 usually by the time the 3 to 12 months are completed to process the fund conversion, the balances are not there anymore); We 22 23 are looking at introducing an automatic rebalancing feature and 2.4 automated processing of TDA contributions from CUNY and Charter 25 Schools. Currently, this is a very manual process and it

1 TRS Regular Board Meeting, NOVEMBER 18, 2010 2 really needs to be improved. There are various other 3 upgrades that we are looking at, but those are a few of the 4 highlights.

5 There are three (3) broad types of consulting costs that б will be incurred: i) Consultants needed to backfill for 7 current TRS staff, so that we can free them up to participate 8 in the project without hurting the ongoing operation of our 9 existing systems. ii) Consultants needed to assist in the comparative analysis project so that we can evaluate what is the 10 11 best way to upgrade our computer system to support the new 12 business rules. iii) Consultants to provide specialized 13 services, including: quality assurance, business rule extraction and validation, change management, project time and 14 15 cost estimation, and business analysis. As indicated in the 16 resolution, if approved, the Corpus funding for this work will come 100% from the Variable and TDA fund fees. 17

Before I go back to the resolution, are there any questions or comments? Hearing none, I will go back to the resolution and read the Resolved.

21 Resolved, that the agency budget for Fiscal Year 2011 be 22 increased in the amount of \$1,850,000.00, to be taken from TDA 23 and Variable Program funds, to provide for this enhancement of 24 the TDA assessment and analysis project.
